Dear Parents and Carers,

Updates

<u>P.E</u>

P.E this term is athletics and as the children prepare for sports day, P.E will take place mostly outdoors. Please ensure your child's kit is appropriate for this; footwear, such as trainers, will be required and warm clothes for those chilly days. P.E. will continue to take place on a **Monday** with Miss McHamilton. <u>Please ensure your</u> child has their P.E kit in school and it is named!

Reading

Many of the children are now beginning to read books that are much longer and more challenging. Books will continue to be changed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday, however, please do not feel that your child has to have read their whole book in two days! We would rather the children read a bit each evening and fully understand what they have read with some questions from yourself than race through a book and not know what has happened. Please continue to send your child's reading book and 'Home School Record' into school every day so that we can add Dojo points. Additionally, please ensure the Home School Record is signed when your child has completed their book.

Homework

Just a reminder that homework is given out every **Friday** and is expected back in school on the following **Thursday.** I will continue to run a homework club every Wednesday lunchtime for those children who cannot complete it at home **with good reason**.

The children are improving enormously with their times tables so we will continue to have a times table challenge every **Friday**. Times tables are very easy to practice at home so please take the opportunity to do so with your child whenever you can.
