**Year 2** children will be tested over a period of days from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May in as informal a manner as we can as to mirror normal classroom practice. These assessments will be used to support teacher assessment judgements for Reading and Maths. Writing evidence will be gathered throughout May and into June to support teacher assessment judgements.

**Year 1** children will be screened for the National Phonics Screening Check in school by a member of staff they know during week commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June.

**Year 4** children will undertake the Multiplication Tables Check from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June until Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June.

## The King's Coronation

The King's Coronation will be celebrated by holding a non-uniform day on 5<sup>th</sup> May where the children are invited to wear red, white and blue. We are also hosting a competition for the children to make a crown or tiara which will be judged in celebration assembly - we want our prince and princesses to look the part!

We will be having a picnic lunch for families from 12-noon until 12:45 pm so that we can celebrate the event as a whole school (we hope the weather is sunny to allow for this!). A staff member will open the gates at 12 pm.

In addition to this, we will also be completing work to mark the significant event in living history. Our children will learn about the Royal family and the importance of the Coronation.
