A section 8 Ofsted Monitoring Inspection took place at Sutterton on 27<sup>th</sup> September. The inspection was a highly positive experience and the hard work of all staff members was recognised. The school is very much on track to be good at the next inspection and the report and accompanying letter will be published on Sutterton's School Dojo followed shortly by the Ofsted and school website. The school was given a few recommendations to ensure it will become good and an action plan has been put in

place and work will commence immediately.

All in all, it is great to know that leaders are making the right decisions and ensuring that the school is very much on track. It is also worth noting how hard the entire staff team have worked, ever single day, to ensure the children are getting the best.
