particularly as the Government has encouraged all schools to choose this route before 2030. Academies are state maintained schools free to all children. They are run separately from the Local Authority and have an agreement with the Government which provides funding directly to the Academy Trust. They follow the same rules as all other state-funded schools over admissions, pupils with Special Educational Needs and exclusions. They are inspected by Ofsted. We are choosing to make this proposal as a positive way forward for our school which will enable us to continue to improve the opportunities we provide for your children. An informal consultation
