## Why Attendance Matters

Fixed Penalty Notices are fines issued when a child's school attendance falls below acceptable levels without valid reasons. These notices are part of legal measures designed to encourage consistent attendance and address issues of persistent absenteeism. We understand that there may be genuine reasons for a child's absence or lateness, and our priority is to work with families to address any underlying issues. If you are facing challenges that impact your child's attendance, please reach out to us. We can provide guidance, support, and resources to help improve your child's attendance.
