The Church Year starts at Advent. In church different colours represent different seasons.

Purple is used for times of deep thinking and reflection. It is also sometimes used at adult funerals.	Red is used for saints’ days who have died as martyrs and also represents the flame of the Holy Spirit.	Green is used to represent quiet growth during the time between festivals and seasons.	Gold used for special occasions.	White represents purity (as opposed to sin which is scarlet). It often represents a season of celebration rather than a day.	On these two days of the year the church is stripped bare of all decoration and flowers.
Used during Advent and Lent	Pentecost/Whitsun Martyr’s saints’ days	Used throughout Ordinary Time.	Used for special days of celebration, such as Easter Day and Christmas	Used in the seasons of Easter and Christmas and for saints who were not martyred.	Good Friday and Holy Saturday

Belt of Truth Chris can hardly believe his eyes when Holly the Defender suddenly reappears in the iSingPOP house! Holly has arrived from the village of Villagetton, and she needs help.</p> <p>The creator of her game has given her a short holiday while a brand-new quest is being prepared. Before she returns to defend the villagers, Holly has been told to learn about something called the “Armour of God.” Chris is thrilled, Sandy is intrigued, and Holly is determined to start her training straight away. Just as the team begin learning about the first piece of armour — the Belt of Truth — Kirsty arrives with a tool belt, convinced she has been called in to fix a broken shelf.</p> <p>Will Kirsty’s belt turn out to be the perfect way to understand the Belt of Truth? But before Holly can focus on her training, trouble is brewing back in the village of Villagetton. Chris reports that chaos has broken out while Holly has been away, and it sounds like the mischievous Ned the Nasty may be behind it all.</p> <p>As Holly begins learning about the Breastplate of Righteousness, strange voices start whispering doubts and accusations. Emma arrives just in time with a costume breastplate to help demonstrate what protecting your heart might look like.</p> <p>Will Holly learn how to guard her heart against Ned’s tricks?
